

# Qualsafe Activity First Aid – Level 2 Award (RQF)

#### Who should attend?

This qualification is for people who have a specific interest or responsibility in voluntary and community activities such as sports.

## **Course Aims & Objectives**

The objective of the qualification is to benefit Learners by enabling them to attain the knowledge and practical competencies needed to deal with a range of first aid situations.

By the end of the course delegates will:

- Understand the role and responsibility of a first aider
- Be able to
  - o assess an incident
  - o manage an unresponsive casualty who is breathing normally
  - o manage an unresponsive casualty who is not breathing normally
  - o recognise and assist a casualty who is choking
  - manage a casualty with external bleeding
  - o manage a casualty who is in shock
  - o manage a casualty with a minor injury
  - Conduct a secondary survey
- Administer:
  - o first aid to a casualty with injuries to bones, muscles and joints
  - o first aid to a casualty with suspected head, neck and back injuries
  - o first aid to a casualty with suspected chest and abdominal injuries
  - o first aid to a casualty with eye injuries
  - o first aid to a casualty with sudden poisoning
  - o first aid to a casualty with anaphylactic shock
- Know how to provide first aid to a casualty with suspected major illness
- Know how to provide first aid to a casualty who is experiencing the effects of extreme heat and cold
