



Qualsafe Emergency Paediatric First Aid – Level 3 Award (RQF)

Who should attend?

This qualification is for anyone who cares for children and babies; including parents, guardians, grandparents or people who have a professional involvement with children and babies.

Course Aims & Objectives

The objective of the qualification is to benefit Learners by enabling them to attain the knowledge and practical competencies needed to deal with a range of first aid situations when looking after children.

By the end of the course delegates will:

- Understand the role and responsibilities of the paediatric first aider
- Be able to:
 - assess an emergency situation safely
 - provide first aid for an infant or a child who is unresponsive and breathing normally
 - provide first aid for an infant or a child who is unresponsive and not breathing normally
 - provide first aid for an infant or a child who is choking
 - provide first aid to an infant or a child with external bleeding
 - provide first aid to an infant or a child who is suffering from shock
- Understand how to administer first aid to an infant or a child with bites, stings and minor injuries

Certification

Delegates are assessed throughout the course by the trainer and need to complete a written assessment at the end of the course. Successful delegates will receive a Qualsafe Level 3 Award in Emergency Paediatric First Aid Certificate. Certificates are valid for 3 years and then delegates will need to re-sit the qualification to remain qualified (this must be attended no later than 28 days after the expiry on the original certificate).
