Who should attend?

The one-day course is for delegates who have already completed the full Managing Safely course. Delegates get to refresh their knowledge on the key parts of the full Managing Safely course by relating them to a plan-do-check-act safety and health management system, with leadership at the heart of it all.

- Build on existing understanding and capabilities.
- Understand how good leadership can influence in health and safety.
- Manage health and safety in the workplace more effectively.
- Refresh knowledge of crucial health and safety terms.
- Update understanding of the critical benefits and components of a health and safety management system.
- Review the different types of performance measurements.
- Identify how the law can affect health and safety in the workplace.
- Assess, reduce, and control risk in the workplace.
- Learn how to apply risk profiling in an organisation.
- Understand the importance of lessons learnt and continuous improvement.
